For the holistic development and sensitization of the students and the neighbouring communities under the supervision of **Dr Pardeep Kumar Jain (Coordinator UBA CELL)** various activities are conducted with the help of SLIET and MHRD (GOI). Unnat Bharat Abhian a flagship program of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India a special cell is created for the upliftment of the society and students. Under UBA cell SLIET adopted 7 neighbouring villages **Badrukhan, Duggan, Sheron, Qila Bharian, Namol, Loha Khera, Jharo** Sangrur district of Punjab.

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## 219 persons with disabilities provided with tricycles, hearing aids and wheel chairs

With the assistance of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, and Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India (ALIMCO), a camp was organised for the persons

with disabilities at Longowal village, about 20 kilometers from here.

Professor (Dr) Pardeep Kumar Jain, Coordinator of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan of Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology (SLIET), Longowal, said that at the camp as many as 219 persons with various types of

disabilities were provided with rehabilitation equipment aids, like tricycles, wheel chairs, walking sticks, hearing aids, artificial limbs.

Professor Manoj Goyal, a co-coordinator of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, also spoke about the activities of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, saying that the SLIET has adopted seven villages under the Abhiyan. In this camp, a lot of beneficiaries were from these villages, he added.

Ramveer Singh, Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur, was the chief guest at the function. Dr Anjali from the ALIMCO and Gobind Singh Longowal, president of SGPC, also participated in the function.



## Ration provided to 235 needy families during covid-19 lockdown

Under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) of Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology (SLIET), Longowal, during Covid-19 lockdown period ration and other products were provided to about 235 needy families in seven villages, adopted by the SLIET, namely Sheron, Lohakhera, Jharon, Killabharian, Namol, Duggan and Badrukhan, all situated near Longowal. The ration was provided, especially to migratory workforce.

Giving this information, Coordinator of the UBA Professor Pardeep Kumar Jain from the SLIET, further said that besides distribution of ration, about 1,000 home-made masks had also been distributed to doctors, police officers, officials and general

public during the lockdown period. All the activities were undertaken with the cooperation of Kamaljit Singh, President of Baba Farid Education and Welfare Society (Regd), Longowal; Dr Manoj Goyal, Associate Professor at the SLIET, and Professor Pardeep Kumar Jain. Besides the seven adopted villages, activities were also undertaken in two more villages, namely Longowal and Bahadurpur. Professor Jain further said that they had not confined themselves to only distribution of ration but also worked in the villages to address the domestic violence issues in the villages as domestic violence had increased during this period. He said that many under privileged children of daily wagers were also identified who were provided school bags, stationery and books.
