1. Purpose

This MoU aims to establish a collaborative relationship between **Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, Longowal (SLIET) and Namoh Toolings** to provide internship/Summer training opportunities for qualified and interested students from SLIET's B.Tech. and integrated certificate and diploma (ICD) programs as per mutually agreed duration within the SLIET norms facilitating practical experience under umbrella of Namoh Toolings.

2. Scope of Cooperation

- Internship Duration: Internships are offered for a minimum period of 6 months, extendable based on performance and business needs for mutually agreed period.
- Field of Internship: Internships will focus on Metal Cutting Industry, supply chain management, and related fields, providing exposure to Namoh Toolings operations, Automobile industry, Defence industry, Power Generation, Medical & other allied industries.

3. Responsibilities of Namoh Toolings

- Provide internship opportunities for (5-10) interested students each academic years (Online & offline mode as per feasibility)
- Offer practical training/Projects and exposure to the Metal Cutting industry operations.
- Assign mentors to guide interns through their internship/ training period.
- Evaluate interns as per SLIET rule and provide feedback to SLIET.

4. Responsibilities of SLIET

- Select students based on academic performance, interest and suitability for the internship roles.
- Coordinate with Namoh Toolings to ensure that the selected students meet the required qualifications.
- Provide academic support and track the progress of students during the internship.
- As per their need we may conduct interview on behalf of them (if requested)

5. Terms of Engagement

- Interns will be subject to the standard policies of Namoh Toolings regarding conduct, confidentiality, and safety.
- Interns may receive a stipend/PPO/ Direct Placement as agreed upon by both parties.
- No financial liabilities will be bear by SLIET Longowal. SLIET will only depute the students

6. Intellectual Property

Any intellectual property developed during the internship period shall be handled in accordance with the existing policies of Namoh Toolings & SLIET.

7. Amendment and Termination

This MoU may be amended or terminated by mutual written consent of both parties. Either party may terminate this MoU with a 30-day written notice if terms are not adhered to.

8. Signatory Authority

This MoU will be executed by duly authorized representatives of both institutions.

Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute, conflict of interest or problems arising from the application or interpretation of this MoU shall be resolved by mutual discussion and in good faith by the designated representatives of both the Institutions.

Legal status

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This MoU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation.
