MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

Principal Agreement

Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology, Longowal, Sangrur (Pb.), India (hereinafter referred to as "SLIET, Longowal" and the context so admits includes its successors and assignees) and Amity School of Engineering & Technology (ASET), Amity University Uttar Pradesh, Noida (AUUP), a leading private university of India established and incorporated under Amity University Uttar Pradesh Act, 2005 (UP ACT No.11 of 2005) and UP Private Universities Act 2019 (UP ACT No.12 of 2019) having its registered office at Sector-125, Noida- 201313 (UP), India (hereinafter referred to as "AUUP" which expression shall, unless it is repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns) agree to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to promote cooperation in the fields of education and academic research.

Now it is hereby agreed as follows:

Article 1. Scope of cooperation

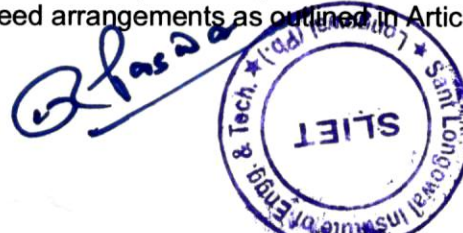
The scope of this MoA covers:

1. Collaboration in joint research projects.
2. Joint Supervision of Ph.D. Program.
3. Visit and exchanges of faculty members, research scientists and students.
4. Exchange of scientific and technical information.
5. Co-organization of STP/FDP, seminars, symposia and conferences.
6. Other activities as may be agreed upon by the Parties.

Article 2. Mechanism for implementation

For the purpose of implementation of this MoA SLIET, Longowal, will be represented by Prof. (Dr.) Surinder Singh, Dean (R&C), Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering and AUUP will be represented by Ms. Asha Premnath, Joint Registrar, Amity University Uttar Pradesh.

These representatives may meet as and when necessary to draw plans of action and to review the progress in the implementation of the agreed arrangements as outlined in Article 1.



If necessary, separate subsidiary agreements may be signed for one or more of the activities mentioned in Article 1 for specific details and terms and conditions. All activities under this MoA shall be subject to availability of resources and approval by the competent authorities of the respective organizations.

Article 3. Financial obligations

For each activity outlined in Article 1, the extent of financial commitment by the two organizations will be separately negotiated and agreed upon. Prior to final agreement and the carrying out of any activity arising from this MoA both SLIET, Longowal and AUUP must obtain the concurrence in writing of their respective finance / Accounts and Audit Sections.

Article 4. Duration of MoA

This MoA will come into force on the date of its execution by the authorized signatories of SLIET, Longowal and AUUP and shall remain in force for a period of 5 years and may be renewed upon its expiry with the agreement of both parties. If the MoA remains dormant for the consecutive years it will be deemed to have lapsed.

Either SLIET, Longowal or AUUP may terminate the MoA by giving 6 months' notice in writing to the other party. The termination of this MoA shall not affect the implementation of the activities already established under it prior to such termination.

Article 5. Amendments

This MoA may only be amended by mutual agreement evidenced in writing by a duly authorized representative from both the organizations.

Article 6. Intellectual Property

Any intellectual property arising out of the implementation of this MoA shall be secured and maintained by mutual consent according to the provisions of the IPR rules of SLIET, Longowal, and those of AUUP.

Article 7. Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute, conflict of interest or problems arising from the application or interpretation of this MoA shall be resolved by mutual discussion and in good faith by the designated representatives of both the organizations as mentioned in Article 2.

Article 8. Legal status

Nothing in this MoA shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties. This MoA is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation.


